Appointment to a Teaching or Research Assistantship is contingent upon admission of the student to the Graduate School prior to the beginning of his/her service or award. Continuation or reinstatement of an appointment is contingent upon good standing in the Graduate School as determined by the Dean of the Graduate School.

Assistantships ordinarily require participation on a half-time basis in teaching or research programs. Assistants are required to register each quarter for a minimum of 10 credits applicable to their advanced degrees. Stipend levels for Graduate Student Service Appointments are published annually.
