

# Division of Spanish and Portuguese Studies

## Spanish Major Requirements

### Sample Spanish course schedules on UW campus:

#### Student A admitted autumn quarter; took 203 in the spring:

Autumn: SPAN 301 and 302; and 392  
Winter: SPAN 303 and 392; SPAN 322  
Spring: SPAN 3XX literature; SPAN 323  
Autumn: SPAN 321; & SPAN 4XX (that does not require SPAN 321 as a prerequisite)  
Winter: SPAN 4XX and SPAN 4XX  
Spring: SPAN 4XX and SPAN 4XX

#### Student B is a heritage student admitted winter quarter:

Winter: SPAN 314; and 392  
Spring: SPAN 315 & 392; 323; & 3xx lit  
Autumn: SPAN 316 and SPAN 321  
Winter: SPAN 322; & SPAN 4XX (that does not require SPAN 322 as a prerequisite)  
Spring: SPAN 4XX and SPAN 4XX  
Summer: SPAN 4XX and SPAN 4XX

#### Student C- transfer, admitted summer quarter; took 203 at community college:

Summer: SPAN 301  
Autumn: SPAN 302 and 392; SPAN 3XX literature  
Winter: SPAN 303 and 392; SPAN 321; & 322  
Spring: SPAN 323; and SPAN 4XX (that does not require 323 as a prerequisite)  
Summer: SPAN 4XX; and SPAN 4XX  
Autumn: SPAN 4XX; and SPAN 4XX

#### Student D is a heritage student admitted autumn quarter:

Autumn: SPAN 314  
Winter: SPAN 315 and 392; SPAN 322  
Spring: SPAN 316 and 392; SPAN 323  
Summer: SPAN 3XX literature  
Autumn: SPAN 321; SPAN 4XX (that does not require 321 as a prerequisite)  
Winter: SPAN 4XX; and SPAN 4XX  
Spring: SPAN 4XX; and SPAN 4XX

#### Student E-transfer, admitted winter quarter; took 301 previously:

Winter: SPAN 302 and 392; SPAN 322  
Spring: SPAN 303 and 392; SPAN 323  
Summer: SPAN 3XX literature  
Autumn: SPAN 321 and SPAN 4XX (that does not require 321 as a prerequisite)  
Winter: SPAN 4XX and SPAN 4XX  
Spring: SPAN 4XX and SPAN 4XX

#### Student F admitted autumn quarter; took 301 @ UW previous summer as non-matriculated student:

Autumn: SPAN 321 and SPAN 3XX literature  
Winter: SPAN 302 and 392, SPAN 322  
Spring: SPAN 303 and 392, SPAN 323  
Autumn: SPAN 4XX and SPAN 4XX  
Winter: SPAN 4XX and SPAN 4XX  
Spring: SPAN 4XX

#### REMEMBER:

1. These are *sample schedules* and do not reflect every possible scenario.
2. Examples show Spanish courses only. In many cases, students will also be taking general education requirements and/or electives. The College of Arts & Sciences lists general education requirements here:

3. SPAN 321 is offered *twice annually: autumn and winter quarters only*  
SPAN 322 is offered *twice annually; winter and spring quarters only*  
SPAN 323 is offered *only once each spring*
4. Students who choose to study abroad will have different schedules. It is important to *make an appointment* with the Spanish adviser for help with academic planning *at least 6 months before* planned departure.
